TITANS NOTES

- **QB MARCUS MARIOTA** is making 1st career postseason start. Is 1 of 5 QBs in NFL history with 9,000+ pass yards (9,476) & 900+ rush yards (913) in 1st 3 seasons. Since entering league in 2015, has 39 TD passes vs. 0 INTs in red zone, highest TD/INT ratio in NFL over span.
- **RB DE MARCO MURRAY** has 225 scrimmage yards (112.5 per game) & 2 rush TDs in 2 career postseason games. Leads NFL with 43 rush TDs & ranks 2nd in league with 5,614 rush yards since 2013. Had 141 scrimmage yards (89 rush, 52 rec.) in last game vs. KC. **RB DERRICK HENRY** led team with career-high 744 rush yards. Had 3 65+ yard TDs from scrimmage in 2017, most in NFL.
- **TE DELANIE WALKER** led team with 74 catches & 807 rec. yards. Is 1 of 2 NFL TEs (**TRAVIS KELCE**) with 800+ rec. yards in each of past 4 seasons. **WR ERIC DECKER** has 30 catches for 415 rec. yards (83 per game) with 7 TD catches in his past 5 vs. KC. **WR RISHARD MATTHEWS** had 105 rec. yards in last meeting.
- **LB WESLEY WOODYARD** led team with career-high 121 tackles. Was 1 of 2 players in NFL (**DEMARIO DAVIS**) with 100+ tackles & 5+ sacks (5). **LB AVERY WILLIAMSON** is 1 of 4 in team history with 2+ seasons with 90+ tackles (92) & 3+ sacks (3). **S KEVIN BYARD** tied for NFL lead with 8 INTs, 3rd most by safety in team history. Had league-leading 3 multi-INT games in 2017. Rookie **CB ADORÉE' JACKSON** was only NFL CB with 70+ tackles (70) & 15+ PD (17). **DT JURRELL CASEY** had 6 sacks, his 5th consecutive season with 5+ sacks.

CHIEFS NOTES

- **QB ALEX SMITH** led NFL with career-high 104.7 rating & was 1 of 3 QBs (**TOM BRADY** & **DREW BREES**) with 4,000+ pass yards (4,042) & fewer than 10 INTs (5). Has 3,000+ pass yards & fewer than 10 INTs in 5 consecutive seasons, longest streak in NFL history. Ranked 3rd in NFL with 67.5 comp. pct. (341 of 505). In 6 career postseason games, has 12 TD passes vs. 2 INTs for 94.5 rating.
- **RB KAREEM HUNT** led NFL with franchise rookie record 1,327 rush yards & is 2nd rookie not selected in 1st round (**PAUL ROBINSON** in 1968) to lead his league in rush yards since 1967. Led all rookies & ranked 3rd in NFL with 1,782 scrimmage yards. Aims for 5th in row with rush TD.
- **TE TRAVIS KELCE** led all NFL TEs with 83 catches & ranked 2nd with 1,038 rec. yards. Is 1 of 2 players in franchise history (**TONY GONZALEZ**) with consecutive seasons with 80+ catches & 1,000+ rec. yards. Has 75+ rec. yards in 2 of past 3 in postseason. **WR-PR TYREEK HILL** ranked 4th in AFC with career-high 1,183 rec. yards. Had 6 50+ yard TDs (5 rec., 1 PR), most in NFL. **WR ALBERT WILSON** aims for 3rd postseason game in row with TD catch.
- **LB JUSTIN HOUSTON** led team with 9.5 sacks. Since entering league in 2011, has 69.5 sacks, 5th most in NFL. Has 3 sacks in past 3 vs. Ten. **CB MARCUS PETERS** has 4 PD & INT in 3 career playoff games. Is only NFL player with 5+ INTs in each of past 3 seasons. Since entering league in 2015, leads league with 19 INTs & 55 PD. **S DANIEL SORENSEN** was 1 of 5 NFL safeties with 80+ tackles (88), sack (1.5) & INT (1).

FALCONS NOTES

- **QB MATT RYAN** has 41,796 career pass yards & surpassed **PEYTON MANNING** (41,626) for most pass yards by player in his 1st 10 seasons in NFL history. Passed for 4,095 yards, his franchise-record 7th consecutive season with 4,000+ yards. In his past 3 games vs. Rams, has 864 pass yards (288 per game), 7 TDs & 0 INTs for 114.4 rating. Has 1,410 pass yards (352.5 per game), 12 TDs & 1 INT for 129.2 rating in his past 4 playoff games. Aims for his 5th in row in postseason with 100+ rating.
- **RB DEVONTA FREEMAN** had 1,182 scrimmage yards, his 3rd consecutive season with 1,000+ scrimmage yards. In 3 career playoff games, has 330 scrimmage yards (110 per game) & 3 TDs (2 rush, 1 rec.). **RB TEVIN COLEMAN** aims for his 4th playoff game in row with TD.
- **WR JULIO JONES** led NFC with 1,444 rec. yards. Has 9,054 career rec. yards & reached 9,000 yards in his 95th game, fastest in NFL history. In his past 4 postseason games, has 30 receptions for 516 yards (129 per game) & 5 TDs. **WR MOHAMED SANU** has TD catch in 2 of his past 3 playoff games.
- **LB DEION JONES** ranked 2nd in NFC with career-high 138 tackles. Has FF, INT & 3 PD in 3 career playoff games. **S KEANU NEAL** led NFC safeties with 113 tackles. Had career-high 13 tackles in SB LI. **LB TAKKARIST MC KINLEY** was only NFL rookie with 5+ sacks (6) & 2+ FFs (2). **DE ADRIAN CLAYBORN** led team with career-high 9.5 sacks. **CB ROBERT ALFORD** ranked 4th in NFL with 20 PD.

- **QB JARED GOFF** ranked 3rd in NFC in rating (100.5) & tied for 5th in NFL in TD passes (28). Had 3 games with 300+ pass yards, 3+ TD passes & 0 INTs, most in NFC.
- **RB TODD GURLEY** led NFL with 2,093 scrimmage yards & 19 TDs. Is 3rd different player in NFL history to have 2,000+ scrimmage yards (2,093), 10+ rush TDs (13) & more than 5 TD catches (6) in single season (HOFers **O.J. SIMPSON**, 1975 & **MARSHALL FAULK**, 2000 & 2001). Had 83 scrimmage yards & rush TD in last game vs. Atl.
- **WR ROBERT WOODS** had career-best 781 rec. yards & tied career-high with 5 TDs. **WR COOPER KUPP** ranked 2nd among NFL rookies in rec. yards (869), 4th in receptions (62) & tied for 4th in TD catches (5). Set franchise rookie records in receptions, rec. yards & TD catches. **WR SAMMY WATKINS** has TD in 4 of his past 5.
- **DT AARON DONALD** led team & tied career-high with 11 sacks & had 5 FFs, most among NFL DTs. Had sack in last game vs. Atl. Since entering league in 2014, leads NFL DTs with 39 sacks. **LB ROBERT QUINN** has 6 sacks & 2 FFs in his past 6. Had sack in only career game vs. Atl. (9/15/13). Since 2011, is 1 of 3 in NFL with 60+ sacks (62.5) & 20+ FFs (20). **LB ALEC OGLETREE** led team with 95 tackles, his 4th time in past 5 seasons leading Rams in tackles. **LB MARK BARRON** has 2 FRs in his past 3 vs. Atl. **CB TRUMAINE JOHNSON** led team with 14 PD.

TODD GURLEY is the third different player in NFL history to have at least 2,000 scrimmage yards, 10 rushing touchdowns and more than 5 touchdown catches in a single season. The other 2 players to accomplish the feat are Pro Football Hall of Famers: **O.J. SIMPSON** (1975) and **MARSHALL FAULK** (2000 and 2001).

BILLS NOTES

- **QB TYROD TAYLOR** will make 1st career postseason start. Led NFL with 0.95 INT pct. (4 INTs in 420 att.). Has 1.4 career INT pct., lowest in NFL history (min. 1,000 att.). Was 1 of 4 NFL QBs with 2,500+ pass yards (2,799) & 400+ rush yards (427) in 2017.
- **RB LE SEAN MC COY** ranked 4th in NFL with 1,138 rush yards & 1,586 scrimmage yards. Has 5 career seasons with 1,500+ scrimmage yards, 2nd most among active players. Has 174 scrimmage yards (87 per game) & rush TD in his past 2 postseason games. Aims for 4th in row vs. Jax. with 100+ scrimmage yards. **RB MIKE TOLBERT** has 3 rush TDs in his past 3 vs. Jax.
- **WR KELVIN BENJAMIN** had 2 TD catches in his last playoff game (2014 NFC Div. with Car., 1/10/15). **TE CHARLES CLAY** led team with 558 rec. yards, his 5th consecutive 500+ rec. yard season.
- **LB PRESTON BROWN** led NFL with career-high 144 tackles. Has 100+ tackles in each of 1st 4 seasons. **S JORDAN POYER** set career-highs in tackles (95), INTs (5) & sacks (2). Was only NFL player with 90+ tackles (95) & 5+ INTs (5). Poyer & **S MICAH HYDE** (5) were only pair of NFL teammates with 5+ INTs each. **CB TRE'DAVIOUS WHITE** tied for NFL rookie lead with 18 PD & tied for 2nd with 4 INTs. **DT KYLE WILLIAMS** has 43.5 career sacks, most by DT in franchise history.
